As part of a contract with the Pittsburgh Public Schools, One Vision One Life maintains a violence prevention presence both in-school and after-school, where kids often get into fights. One Vision One Life staff are currently hosting groups, resolving conflicts, and maintaining a presence at lunches at Oliver High School, Langley High School, Milliones Middle School, and Greenway Middle School. In addition, staff are working outside, after school downtown, outside Oliver High School and Columbus Middle School, outside Milliones Middle School, and at the intersection of Bausmann and Brownsville Roads on the Southside. Parents, school officials, and local law enforcement are pleased with our efforts – we’ve kept things safe after school. So critical is the presence downtown, that presentations have requested by the downtown charter schools and downtown business partners.
